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CLEARWATER MARINE AQUARIUM

Clearwater Marine Aquarium is a refugee aquarium and all the animals are released after being rehabilitated. All the proceeds go to help rehabilitate the sea animals. This aquarium is smaller, but focuses more on education about rescue and preservation. They offer animal interactions, dolphin shows and photo opportunities, stingray feedings, and much more.


They also offer a behind-the-scenes tour, for an additional cost, where you'll be able to explore their working hospital and have a hands-on experience in the Rescue, Rehab, and Release facility.

Strattera® (atomoxetine HCl) is approved for the treatment of attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) in children aged 6 and older, teens, and adults. Strattera should be used as part of a total treatment program for ADHD that may include counseling or other therapies.

Important Safety Information for Strattera

What is the most important information I should know about Strattera?

In some children and teens, Strattera increases the risk of suicidal thoughts or actions. Results from Strattera clinical studies with over 2200 child or teenage ADHD patients suggest that some children and teenagers may have a higher chance of having suicidal thoughts or actions. Although no suicides occurred in these studies, 4 out of every 1000 patients developed suicidal thoughts. Call the doctor right away if your child or teenager has thoughts of suicide or sudden changes in mood or behavior, especially at the beginning of treatment or after a change in dose. Strattera is not approved for major depressive disorder.

Who should not take Strattera?

Strattera should not be taken if you or your child/teenager:

- Are taking or have taken within the past 14 days an anti-depression medicine called a monoamine oxidase inhibitor or MAOI. You or your child/teenager should also not take an

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
